Visibility of your booth is very important to you and we understand that. Help us increase the flow of attendees through the booth areas by providing us with as much information about your booth as possible. What screenings will you be providing? Will your booth offer a door prize &/or food/bottled drinks? The more information you give us, the more we can provide to attendees, and in the advertisement and promotion of the event.

A map of booth locations, a list of groups/booths with a short description of booth subject and/or available services, screenings, and door prizes, a Senior Fest Activity List, and a tote bag suitable for collecting information and "give aways" will be available at the entrance to the Civic Center for all Senior Fest attendees. Promotion will be conducted through advertisements and announcements in The Facts, The Source, and The Bulletin. Announcements and ads in other local publications will be done as the budget allows.
